DPLA in Ohio Overview

- Jillian Carney, Katy Klettlinger, and Shannon Kupfer gave an overview of the DPLA program and website.
- Angela O'Neal gave an update on DPLA in Ohio. She informed the members that a LSTA grant proposal had been submitted to the State Library for a DPLA planning grant. The goal of this planning project is to create a roadmap for establishing a DPLA Service Hub in Ohio. The primary activities of the project are to:
 - Identify a DPLA service model that will best suit the Ohio library and cultural heritage environment, including best practices for shareable metadata
 - Develop a tactical strategic plan for the development of the DPLA application
 - Assist Ohio libraries and cultural heritage institutions in developing a Pathway to DPLA through a survey on digitization programs in Ohio and culminating in a day-long statewide symposium.

Featured Update – IR Day

- Jane Wildermuth shared information about IR Day
 - Originally developed after the dissolution of the DRC
 - Founded by Andrew Harris, Elizabeth Shook, and Jane Wildermuth of Wright State University
 - Held first IR Day on October 24, 2014 at the State Library of Ohio
 - Discussed copyright, open URL, automated workflow
 - Will hold a second meeting on April 17, 2015
