Featured Update: DPLA in Ohio, Angela O'Neal

We've made a lot of progress since our last update. Thanks to the State Library of Ohio and OPLIN, this effort was funded through a planning grant that began in July. The Steering Committee, which consists of lead partners from around the state, held a kick-off meeting on July 25th. Consultants Liz Bishoff and Tom Claeson lead the group through some of the models that exist in other states and discussed some of the challenges we will face going forward. In the afternoon, we selected Working Groups to develop recommendations for six major areas: technical infrastructure, advocacy, metadata standards, governance, legal agreements and sustainability. Each Working Group is co-chaired by two steering committees and has a liaison from one of the Steering Committee chairs (Angela O'Neal, Stephen Hedges and Missy Lodge).

Since July, we put out a call for members of the Working Groups, which have now been selected and are starting to work on their group charges. Our next meeting is Sep. 18th, which will be a GoTo meeting with Emily Gore of DPLA. I'm still working through locations to host but there will be five sites around the state where Steering Committee/Working Group members can participate.

If you are not involved in a Working Group, there are still plenty of opportunities to get involved in the planning process. We will be sending out a survey for all institutions in Ohio to take to give us information about the status of your digital collection and your readiness to participate in DPLA. The

survey will go to one person in each institution, so please ask if you do not receive it. The survey will be sent out Sept. 14th and be open until October 2nd.

Also, save the date for December 3-4th for the DPLA in Ohio Symposium. Note that this is a date change from November 16th, which was changed due to the IMLS Focus meeting scheduled for that day. The Symposium is open to everyone (registration required) and will be an opportunity to learn more about the details of DPLA and engage with the Working Groups on various topics. We will also have preliminary results from the survey.
