

OhioDIG, 2015 November 19

Ohio History Center, 3rd floor, Columbus.

Presentation speakers were Elizabeth Allen, circulation assistant, Bexley Public Library; Jillian Carney, manager of digital services, Ohio History Connection; Shannon Kupfer, digital & tangible media cataloger, State Library of Ohio; Nathan Tallman, digital content strategist, University of Cincinnati who spoke on their project, [Preserve Digital Ohio](#). The four came together and applied for the [2015 ILEAD USA Ohio](#) program with the objective to promote outreach and education in digital preservation matters amongst cultural heritage organizations within Ohio, especially small, volunteer-run organizations. The team gave an overview of ILEAD, discussed how the project was developed, demoed the Digital Content Inventory Tool, and took feedback from the audience for future enhancements. 33 registered for the meeting.

 - Amy McCrory -- getting new library director early next year, also replacing asst. director for IT; photographing 1420 manuscript of Italian hospital records; scanning university alumni magazine; 1922 masters thesis of sociological survey of Columbus, includes photographs, relates neighborhoods to infrastructure
- Ohio History Connection
 - Lilly Birkhimer -- WWI NEH grant continues, following up with institutions on survey, selecting what will be digitized; digitizing collections
 - Jennie Salamon -- 5 new papers on Ohio Memory (including a German language!)
 - Phil Sager -- CONTENTdm work; OHMS (UK) oral history project continues, changes to process to improve user experience using compound objects
 - Jillian Carney/Lilly Birkhimer-- new gallery at OH Center, Lilly worked on Pilot 2 in Gallery 2, "the great collections experiment" to put more stored items on display, focused on decorative arts, shows depth/breadth, new ways to display material, not a lot of interpretation, on purpose; Gallery 3 scheduled for Memorial Day, over 1000 items in space

 - Jane Wu -- just wrapped up search for digital initiatives librarian; digitizing collection; loading born digital materials into bepress repository
- San Diego Air and Space Museum
 - Alan Renga -- remote worker from Columbus, travels to San Diego a lot; working with born digital

 - Meghan Frazier -- OhioLINK implementing digital preservation platform next year, announcement soon, will be hiring someone to help stand up the system; working on several DPLA working groups, very exciting project
- OPLIN
 - Stephen Hedges -- OLC convention did update panel on digitization hubs
 - less popular than session last year
- Columbus Metropolitan Library
 - Aaron O'Donovan -- date of opening for remodeled central! moving their stuff back in April from Whitehall, open in July; metadata cleanup for DPLA; Ohio State journal indexes, indexing handwritten cards that are on microfilm; Dave Lucas collection going online;
- Miami University
 - Marcus Ladd -- [OhioDIG Calendar](#), use it, add things by emailing Marcus or using online form; just finished two days of ArchivesSpace training; planning on doing another round of digital collection and statistics next year; 600 year old Ethiopian book in "Ge'ez", no one knows the language, claim that it was owned by Ethiopian Coptic prince
- Olivia Riley -- out of library works, last job was at Devry University, now at private company in Columbus, not sure when going to be doing digital; worked on newspaper project (USNP) in past, interesting to follow its progress; putting feet in different library areas
- University of Cincinnati
 - retreat on digital curation and digitization, developing a vision for the future
- University Akron
 - Mark Bloom-- grant to reformat Goodyear films about airships, avail online; digitizing school of music recital programs;
- MidPointe Library System
 - Adam Wantner -- working on staff, hope to announce more in January
- State Library of Ohio
 - Katy Klettlinger -- Setting up new digitization lab! located right off main lobby, will be a showpiece; training now, 10' Zeutschel, 40 microfiche a minute scanners, 2 microfilm printer
 - Missy Lodge -- waiting to hear on NEH grant for digitization hubs, for community collaborations; waiting to hear on 21st century LB grant for digital preservation program; celebrating 200th anniversary in 2017
 - Wants to use CurateScape for project on history of library and librarianship in Ohio,
 - Exhibition, book to celebrate
- Bowling Green University
 - Nick Pavlik, just started/moved here from NY, BGU is hiring two archivists

- Cincinnati and Hamilton County Public Library
 - Katrina Marshall -- digitized 4 volume set of Audubon Birds of America, now have special case to hold all volumes that open with display for digital photos, in Cincinnati Room, double elephant folios, digitized copies show sun damage to original book where some pages were open for so long, thinking of turning pages regularly, minimal editing to digital images shows history of book;
- Cleveland Public Library
 - Rachel Senese -- high school yearbooks and newspapers; new microfilm scanner doing local newspapers; golden thread software to test output of their equipment; trying to start blog to report out; upcoming speaker on Cleveland historical CurateScape and pilot project to similar project in Kenya; hope to soon start a oral history project, figuring out hosting platform, don't want to use CONTENTdm for it

 - Janet Carleton-- getting 2 term positions, might be posted in spring, 1 to work with Janet and 1 to work in Archives
