


OLHA Digitization Grants—Requirements

- The collections selected for digitization should be important to the history of the area represented by the applicant and/or to the history of Ohio.
- Digitized materials must be made publicly available on the internet.
- Applicant institution must be an OLHA member.



OLHA Digitization Grants—Funds


- Up to \$2,500/grant
- 50% cash match required
 - New in 2022: volunteer hours can count towards match
- Grant recipients receive an Ohio Memory collection
- Funds awarded in two parts:
 - ¹/₂ at time of award
 - ½ after successful completion of project and final report



OLHA Digitization Grants—Timing

Annual Cycle

- Applications due February 15
- Grantees notified by April 1
- Projects begin May 1
- Projects completed April 30 the following year
- Final report due June 15
